This new version offers a wide range of features designed to enhance audio quality for broadcasters. aixtream now includes full FM processing via Thimeo's Stereo Tool solution, which also includes MicroMPX (μ MPX) encoding for STL. MicroMPX transports a full FM composite MPX signal, including pilot and RDS, at a bitrate of only 320 kbit/s. MicroMPX offers nearly lossless FM encoding and perfectly maintains peak control, even when using composite clipping. Users familiar with Stereo Tool will be happy to hear that the Stereo Tool user interface is fully integrated and supported within aixtream. Thus, users have access to the full suite of Stereo Tools options.
