- Seamless audio routing across large venues, multi-position mix environments, performance facilities, and AV deployments

Built for the next generation of live production, the Dante HD Option Card integrates seamlessly with Avid’s E6LX engines, offering expanded I/O capacity, support for up to eight option cards, and full backward compatibility.
