The hardware player offers failover capability to built-in storage that houses playlists, messages and schedules, ensuring uninterrupted service.

This is an attractive option for corporate, financial and other institutions with sensitive data that require or favor on-prem IT solutions. Self-hosted deployments also feature REST APIs for integrations with third-party systems, including a customer's digital signage CMS. On-prem users can also access API Keys to customize the Barix Remote Control QR Code web app for volume, channels and on-demand playback.
