

CODA Audio LINUS Software Update

CODA's LINUS Control software has had a structure update for new and future Windows platforms. New visual displays for active limiters have been incorporated, to more realistically represent system status. A global power on/off has been added for users convenience. The LINUS Control update comes at the same time as a firmware update for the highly successful new installation power amplifier, the Linus 6.4. This update has improved both the operation and displays for the limiters along with some GUI tweaks and bug fixes.
