

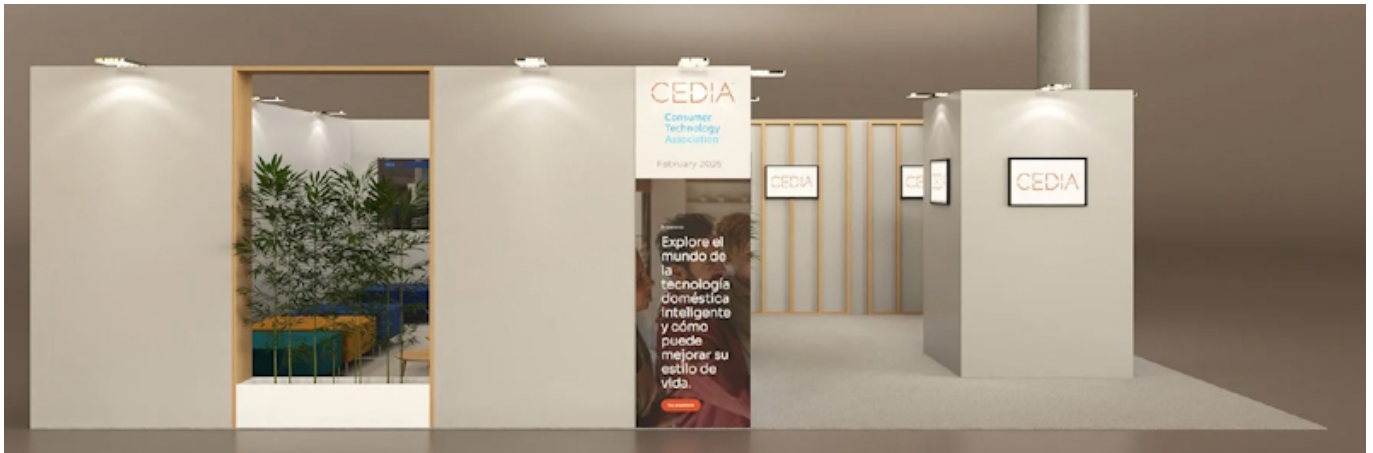
ISE 2025: The Future of Technology
