The connectors are securely mounted to an internal steel backplate, protecting against wear and tear from reconnections. With the PBR XLR 16F DSub in place, engineers can make the required connections efficiently and focus on the session at hand.

The PBR XLR 16F DSub is housed in a reinforced steel chassis with black-anodized aluminum faceplates, delivering durability that stands up to daily professional use while maintaining a refined, cohesive aesthetic alongside other Black Lion Audio gear.
