

BOOM Library March 2026 Update



BOOM Library has released the latest update to its BOOM ONE collection. Update 26-04 delivers over 530 new sound files, 2,500+ individual sounds, and more than 10GB of fresh production-ready audio. This month's release combines detailed percussion recordings with the mechanical textures of woodworking tools, alongside a diverse collection of additional recordings captured in real working environments.

PERCUSSION: Rhythm and Texture includes 126 percussion files covering a wide range of instruments and playing styles. From traditional percussion to world instruments and handheld rhythm tools, the recordings provide multiple performance intensities and variations, giving sound designers flexible material for musical cues, rhythmic design, or layered sound effects.

Instruments recorded include:

These recordings are well suited for rhythmic transitions, musical textures, or isolated hits that need natural character and clarity.

A second major category captures 117 files of woodworking tools operating under real working conditions. Instead of isolated motor sounds, these recordings focus on tools actively interacting with wood, capturing the full mechanical character of cutting, drilling, sanding, and shaping materials.

Tools recorded include:

- Jigsaw
- Circular Saw
- Polishing Machine
- Multitool
- Orbital Sander
- Plunge Router

These sounds are ideal for workshop scenes, construction environments, or mechanical design work that requires authentic tool recordings.

More than 250 additional files round out the update with a variety of recordings captured in real environments and practical settings. A notable part of this collection comes from an extensive pottery workshop recording session that documents the full process of shaping and working clay.
