

Celemony Julian Coryell Tonalic Update



Tonalic is the plug-in from Celemony, creators of Melodyne, that brings real performances by world-class studio musicians directly into the DAW, adapting them musically to your own chords, tempo, and groove, with the sound, the feel, and all the performance magic that happens between the notes. Tonalic is a platform that expands regularly - at least every three months - with recordings from new musicians and styles. This April, guitarist, songwriter, and producer Julian Coryell (pictured above) marks the first update.

Julian, son of jazz legend Larry Coryell and the youngest graduate of Berklee College, spent years on tour with Alanis Morissette, Jewel, and Aimee Mann before going his own way as a sought-after session musician. The new Tonalic patterns reflect the full breadth of that musical life: Flamenco, Gypsy, Indie Pop, Latin, and Jazz - styles with deep roots that have been nearly impossible to get convincingly in a DAW context. Julian's recordings, with their numerous variations, transitions, and endings, are a genuine enrichment for both the Tonalic arranger and studio editions.
