While most drum machine plugins focus only on sounds, DrumX emphasizes feel, swing, and pocket first, offering hundreds of exclusive grooves covering R&B/Funk, Dance/Industrial, Pop/Ballads, Hip-Hop, and Electronic music. Each drum machine has been meticulously captured with multiple sampling layers, tape saturation stages, and machine-specific parameter controls - preserving the true character and behavior of the original hardware.
