
Songs.de

- Algorithms dictate who gets discovered favoring major labels and mainstream acts.
- Independent artists face pay rates too low to sustain their careers.

Even government-backed studies in Europe have confirmed these inequalities, highlighting the lack of transparency and fairness in current streaming economics. Songs.de takes a radically different approach: fair pay, transparency, and independence.

Key Features:

- Artists set the price whether €0.05, €0.09, or more per stream. They define the value of their music.
- Custom artist pages with biography, links, music player, and an integrated QR code for gigs, posters, merch, and social media.
- No algorithms, no gatekeeping every artist has equal visibility; discovery is organic, not manipulated.
- Global reach available in 8 languages, designed for international audiences with full tax compliance.
- Fan interaction comments, ratings, and playlist features turn streaming into a community experience.
- Sustainable revenue every stream continues to generate income, long after release.
- For artists, it means dignity, independence, and the ability to actually live off their music.
- For labels, it means stronger monetization strategies and flexible control over catalogs.
- For fans, it means direct support of the musicians they love, without hidden algorithms or exploitative systems.

Founder Jens Reese explains:

- "Songs.de is more than just a platform. It's a statement that streaming doesn't have to be exploitative.
- Every song, every play, should mean recognition and fair income for the person who created it.
- We are building a movement together with artists, labels, and fans for a sustainable future in music."

Songs.de has already attracted independent artists and labels worldwide, with growing momentum fueled by press coverage and grassroots support. In Germany, national TV (NDR Hamburg Journal) has reported on the platform, highlighting its potential to disrupt the status quo. The project is not just about technology, but about reshaping the culture of streaming. It invites musicians and listeners alike to choose fairness over fractions and become part of a movement that restores value to music.
