As such, seven technologically advanced legato techniques - including EXTENDED techniques that are the most advanced patches ever created by Spitfire Audio, such as accented MARCATO (performed with a strong accented front to the note, presented as a shorter note length than STACCATO with the option of timed release triggers) and 'soft swell' entries for single long notes triggered by key velocity - work with stupendous sampling depth to provide unparalleled expression and realism. Realistically, in fact, ABBEY ROAD ORCHESTRA: FLUTES PROFESSIONAL marks the absolute pinnacle of detail, expression, and playability, capturing the essence of a flautist's seamless transitions, meticulously recorded for smooth and expressive note changes, allowing anyone to bring their orchestral vision to life and inspire new compositions. Clearly this is helped by the fact that ABBEY ROAD ORCHESTRA: FLUTES PROFESSIONAL features 16 curated mic signals for microscopic mix control, including two hand-crafted mix signals by GRAMMY® Award-winning engineer extraordinaire Simon Rhodes, resulting in an exquisitely authentic flute sound that embodies the timeless essence of one of the most renowned recording spaces in the world - namely, Abbey Road Studios' Studio One - as a masterfully recorded virtual instrument.

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An alternative - admittedly equally enticing - choice is available to those who do not need the tweak-ability of all those 16 signals or extended playability. Please welcome ABBEY ROAD ORCHESTRA: FLUTES CORE to the production table. This virtual instrument offers key articulations and playing styles; indeed, its LYRICAL LEGATO and PERFORMANCE LEGATO, wide selection of longs and shorts, and control over a variety of articulations allow users to create both intimate and epic soundscapes. Simon Rhodes' Mix 1 may well only feature as a single signal option this time, but being recorded in the timeless acoustics of Abbey Road Studios' Studio One obviously provides realism of the highest order.

Of course, Studio One needs no introduction as the world's largest purpose-built recording studio, having hosted celebrated classical recordings ranging from English composer Sir Edward Elgar to Russian composer, pianist, and conductor Sergei Prokofiev, as well as iconic film scores spanning 1981's *Raiders of the Lost Ark* (John Williams), 1983's *Star Wars: Return of the Jedi* (John Williams), and 2001-2003's *The Lord of the Rings* trilogy (Howard Shore) to more recent releases, including 2022's

Ta’r (Hildur Guðnado’ttir) and 2024’s Gladiator II (Harry Gregson-Williams). It is also home to one of the world’s greatest in-house collections of vintage and modern microphones, while a 72-channel Neve 88 RS large-format mixing console with a unique and comprehensive surround monitor section acts as the centrepiece of its control room. It is little wonder, then, that Studio One is the perfect setting for Spitfire Audio’s ABBEY ROAD ORCHESTRA... series sessions, meticulously curated, recorded, and programmed to deliver the world’s most detailed orchestral sampling, starting with ABBEY ROAD ORCHESTRA: LOW PERCUSSION - laying the foundations for the series in question as the culmination of over 20 years of sample experience and innovation to offer incredible precision across an encyclopaedic selection of orchestral and cinematic percussion performed by British world-class percussionist Joby Burgess (Black Panther, Mission: Impossible) - and now arriving at ABBEY ROAD ORCHESTRA: FLUTES as the ultimate tool for anyone’s creative compositional needs. Needless to say, whichever version of ABBEY ROAD ORCHESTRA: FLUTES anyone might choose to work with, rest assured that they are in good (recorded) company.

Clearly, company co-founder Paul Thomson - an accomplished composer in his own right - can rightfully supply some sympathetic closing commentary: “There’s just so much beautiful, natural dynamic in these recordings, and in the way that the library has been assembled by the team at Spitfire Audio. It just sounds so glorious! It fits that expressive need that you have with the flutes, as well as giving you a kind of aggressive style, even though the flute is not the most aggressive instrument. It’s not something that has massive dynamic range in the orchestra, but has its own character, so what I love about ABBEY ROAD ORCHESTRA: FLUTES is that we’ve captured bags of character from these incredible flautists who have played on the library.”
