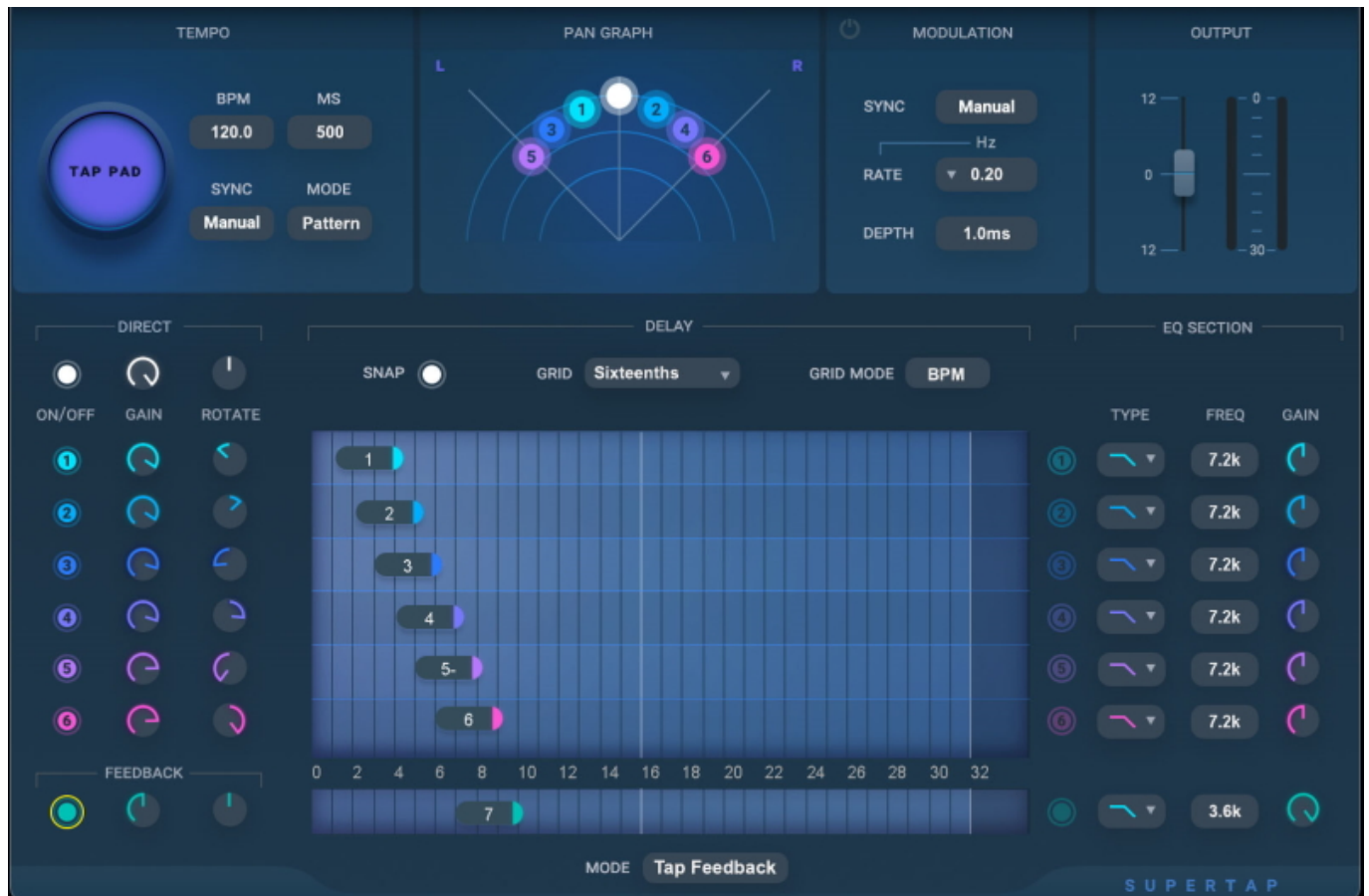


Waves V15
